- **Personal and Professional Success:** The course also includes two all new-features ("Psychology and Your Personal Success" in every section and "Psychology and Your Professional Success" in most sections) to further demonstrate how knowing psychology, along with a growth mindset and grit, can help students succeed in the real world.

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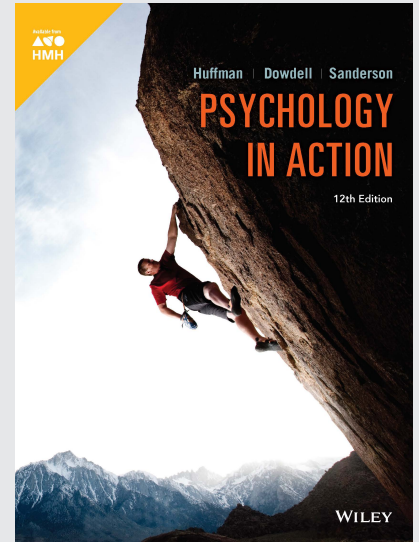


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
